Paul has worked as a scene and costume designer for the Finborough Theatre in England and designed Angels in America: Millennium Approaches and Mere Mortals for the Connecticut Repertory Theatre.

Some of the more recent shows he designed for HPT are St. Nicholas; My Child, My Child, My Alien Child; The Pillowman; Featuring Loretta; Thom Pain (based on nothing); The Lonesome West; Dog Sees God; Blackbird; House; and The Collection. Don has received four B. Iden Payne awards and a Critics' Table Award for his design work.

AUGUSTINE EARLY OEY HOOD

... is a longtime HPT Core Company member whose recent acting credits include The Collection and bombs in your mouth (HPT) (Austin Critics Table nomination); Killer Joe (Capital T Theatre); Have You Ever Been Assassinated? (Rude Mechs); The Glory of Living, The Water Principle, and Blur (HPT); and The Collection (Critics Table Award, Payne nomination) and Bleacher Bums (Payne nomination) for the Subterranean Theatre Company, Joey is originally from Hattiesburg, MS, where he attended the University of Southern Mississippi. He moved to Austin in 1997 and has loved every moment since. This is his first attempt at treading the stage solo. Joey would like to dedicate his performance to his mother, Beverly Hood. STAGE MANAGER TAYLOR KULHANEK

... recently earned her BFA in Theatre Design from Baylor University. Previous stage management roles include FronteraFest 2010, Leave it to Beverly (DA! Theatre Collective), Iphigenia 2.0, Picasso at the Lapin Agile, The Mommy Confessions, and True West. Costume design credits include All My Sons and The Tempest. ABOUT THE CAST AND CREW OF

The Atheist

... was born in Galway, Ireland and worked as a journalist there briefly after college before moving to the United States in 1994. After four years of working at a pub and writing on Martha's Vineyard, he enrolled in Boston University's playwriting school, where he now teaches. He was named 2003's Best Young Playwright by Boston Magazine and was a Huntington Playwright Fellow in 2005. *The Atheist* ran in New York in 2006, in London and Boston in 2007, and was recently revived in New York with Campbell Scott.

VIDEO DESIGNER CHRISTOPHER RUSCH

...is a local filmmaker who has written and directed two short films in the last three years (*The Mechanic, Closing Night*), both SXSW Official Selections. He won a Texas Filmmaker Production Fund Grant for a feature film, *Dirty Hands*, that he will begin shooting later this year. Christopher is also developing a project combining an interactive website, still photography, and documentary film titled *City Folk: Stories from the Street* that attempts to give a face to the Austin homeless and address our city's current and future mental health paradigm.

DIRECTOR KENWEBSTER

...is the artistic director of HPT. Most recently, he directed The Collection and bombs in your mouth for HPT, and appeared in The Collection, Blackbird, and House. In 2008, he was named Outstanding Director of a Comedy at the Austin Circle of Theatre's B. Iden Payne Awards for Dog Sees God; he won the same award the previous year for The Pillowman. That year he was also nominated for an Austin Critics' Circle Award for directing The Pillowman and The Lonesome West. At the 2007 Austin Critics' Table Awards, he was named Outstanding Lead Actor for his one-man performances in both St. Nicholas and Thom Pain (based on nothing). In total, Webster has been nominated for 46 B. Iden Payne Awards and 21 Critics' Table Awards for acting, directing, and producing. His film and television credits include Waking Life, A Scanner Darkly, an episode of Friday Night Lights, and the recent HBO film Temple Grandin. In 2006, the Austin Critics' Table inducted Webster into the Austin Arts Hall of Fame.
