ACT FIVE

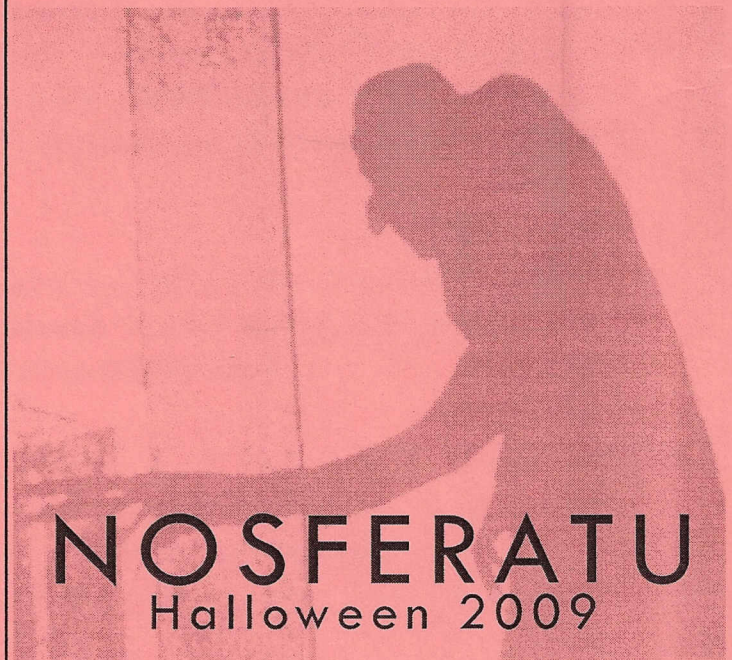
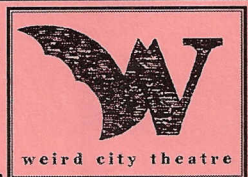
Sc. 1: Julia's dressing room, early evening.
