#### **Directors Notes**

About twenty years ago I had the opportunity to work on an AIDS benefit that was a *The Sound of Music* Sing-A-Long party, and I was struck by how enthusiastically the packed Paramount audience sang each number with full, unbridled gusto. I made a mental note that if,I ever directed the musical, that I wanted to create a communal experience for the audience that fostered that camaraderie, where people could sing along if they felt so inspired. Fast forward a decade and I visited the Rodgers and Hammerstein organization, where the staff musicologist told me that R&H originally opened the musical with Maria in a tree with her guitar, where she simply and tenderly sang "The Sound of Music." All of that twirling in the Alps business started when the movie was made.

My immediate reaction was that I wanted to see THAT production, where Maria is a musician, who brings music—and along with it—life and love, back into the rigid Von Trapp home. It set in motion the desire to curate a diverse cast that was made of music, where our storytellers were also the musicians. In our scenic design you see that the piano itself seems to be the firmament from which Maria's tree grows. A few years ago I toured Munich and Austria and I saw that the huge, festive Biergartens foster the kind of shared audience experience I was after. Consequently, we placed this production in the kind of Biergarten we enjoy in Fredericksburg or New Braunfels, complete with a Bavarian Oompah band to welcome us.

I and the design team have set this story in contemporary times with modern clothing, reinvented specifically for this moment in our city, our state, our country. The disturbing and frightening rise of neo-Nazis and white supremacists in our nation, that manifests in anti-Semitism, opposition to immigrants, and attacks on Asian American, Black, Latine and LGBTQ+ communities, made it imperative to me to have representation of each of these communities in our cast and crew. Rodgers and Hammerstein confronted dark societal issues like racism head-on in their beloved musicals, but the light always wins out. This production is dedicated to the DREAMERS.
