- All submissions should be between 5-15 minutes.
- All submissions should explore the topic of mental health (anxiety, depression, PTSD, or other depressive disorders) and graduate school.
- Submissions should ideally contain between 2-6 characters.
- Plays with extensive technical requirements will be considered but those with fewer demands will receive stronger consideration.
